## JOB SAFE PRACTICES Green Bean Coffee Roaster

ITEM	HAZARD H/M/L	INJURY/RISK	RESPONSIBILITY
<b>DO NOT</b> overfill the roaster  <b>DO NOT</b> block the roasting vent  <b>ENSURE</b> the chaff collector and screen is cleaned after each use  <b>DO NOT</b> expose the roaster to moisture  <b>DO NOT</b> remove the housing cover from the roaster	Fire  Electric Shock	Burns  Electrocution	<b>Store and Department Management –</b> To inspect and maintain equipment and to inform, instruct, train and supervise staff.  <b>Store staff –</b> To work safely, to report unsafe conditions and not operate faulty or unsafe equipment.  <b>All staff –</b> To identify and report unsafe conditions and implement the Out of Service tag procedure.
<b>DO NOT</b> touch the glass roasting chamber or the metal above the roasting chamber during the roasting cycle  <b>ENSURE</b> the roaster is completely cooled before touching it in the event of a fire  <b>DO NOT</b> stop a roast by turning off both switches.	Hot Surfaces	Burns	
<b>DO NOT</b> spray aerosols in the vicinity of the roaster while it is in operation  <b>ENSURE</b> that the only gas as specified on the unit is used  <b>ENSURE</b> electric power, gas and gas valves are turned off after each use  <b>ENSURE</b> electric power, gas and gas valves are turned off in the event of a fire in the roasting chamber	Explosions  Fire  Smoke  Electric Shock	Burns  Serious Injury  Death	
<b>DO NOT</b> leave deli unattended when the roaster is in operation  <b>DO NOT</b> use aggressive cleaners or abrasive products (as per manufacturers recommendations)	Malfunctions  Thermal Stress	Burns  Cuts & Abrasions	

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
