Stockroom - Walkie stacker

ITEM	HAZARD H/M/L	INJURY/RISK	RESPONSIBILITY
<p>Ensure battery charging takes place only in a well ventilated area, away from any ignition source and clear of any stock.</p> <p>Ensure the battery lid is left up while charging.</p> <p>Use the handle provided to remove battery leads.</p> <p>Manufacturer's operating instructions.</p>	Hydrogen release – charging battery	Explosions, fire	<p>Store and Department Management – To inspect and maintain equipment and to inform, instruct, train and supervise staff.</p> <p>Store staff – To work safely, to report unsafe conditions and not operate faulty or unsafe equipment.</p> <p>All staff – To identify and report unsafe conditions and implement the Out of Service tag procedure.</p> <p>Note – Before operating the Walkie stacker staff must undergo accredited training.</p> <p>Check the Walkie stacker controls before each use; that is, forward, reverse, lift, horn, brakes.</p> <p>No person is permitted to ride on the Walkie stacker.</p> <p>Do not use a Walkie stacker on scissor lifts or dock levellers.</p> <p>Ensure you remove the key after using the Walkie stacker.</p>
